- Celiac disease affects approximately 1% of the global population, causing an autoimmune reaction to gluten ingestion.
- o Non-Celiac Gluten Sensitivity (NCGS) impacts up to 13% of the population
- According to GIG's research in 2022:
  - o 71% of gluten-free individuals are concerned about the safety of hospital food
  - o 95% of gluten-free individuals feel safer at a GFFS Validated Safe Spot
